The 2nd Annual Chair Affair

Artists old and artists young are invited to show off their talents in the Chair Affair, an event sponsored by the Leavenworth Main Street Program, Inc. during the 2nd Saturday celebration, May 12, "Gallery Walk: Everything Art."

- Participants (an individual, a group of individuals, an organization, or a school class) will take an ordinary chair and decorate it in any "artistic" way.

- Participants will team up with a Leavenworth Main Street member for the competition. This participant/MS member partnership may be established by the Chair Affair participant or by random Main Street Association assignment.

- Chairs may be supplied by the participant or may be chosen from a limited group of donated chairs that will become available around the middle of March.

- Chairs will be displayed on the sidewalk in front of the Main Street member's business during the 2nd Saturday celebration on May 12, and for the one-month period following.

- Chairs will be sold by silent auction to the highest bidder at the end of the display period. If visitors like a chair but don't want to buy it, they may also vote for the chair by placing their spare change in a "voting can" within the store.

- The winning chair will be the chair that brings in the most money between the silent auction and the "voting can" combined. The artist of the winning chair will nominate a deserving area "arts" group to receive 50% of all incoming proceeds from the contest. The other 50% will go to the Leavenworth Main Street 2nd Saturday fund. Sample arts groups could be the Leavenworth County Artists Association, the Carnegie Arts Center, the Leavenworth High School Art Department, etc.
